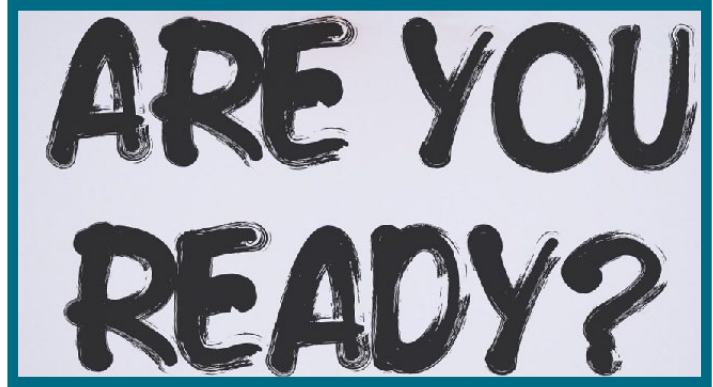

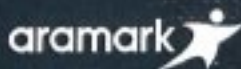

Student schedules for high school students will be available to the students at 7 p.m. on **Monday, August 21**.



How to Set Up a Home Access Center Account

To create an account you must have a current and valid e-mail address on file with your school.

1. Supply a valid e-mail address to your school (if you haven't done so already).
2. Set up an ID. The Home Access Center (HAC) can be found on district.d303.org in the "For Parents" menu.

VERY IMPORTANT - City name must be entered according to the posted instructions. Video tutorials are available online to assist with login and navigation.

Notification of Transportation Routes

Bus route information will be available for all K-12 students on **Wednesday, August 16** at 12 p.m. Bus route information can be viewed by going to Bus Routes E-Link located on the "For Parents" menu on www.d303.org. Please note that for the first two weeks of the school year, we will not make adjustments to the transportation routes. Our transportation department will collect suggestions about the routes and will make adjustments where necessary after the first two weeks of classes.



D303 Electronic Payments

District 303 utilizes PushCoin to pay for all school activities, including registration, sports, lunch, summer camps and more! If you would like to learn more about PushCoin, visit www.PushCoin.com. Pushcoin accepts credit/debit card or ACH check (echeck) payments (for credit/debit card payments a 2.79%+.25 cent processing fee is applied).

Families new to the district will be provided a login ID and temporary password for HAC and a registration code for Pushcoin once enrollment is complete and residency has been verified. Please contact your school's office if you need assistance with HAC or Pushcoin.
