



Kindergarten Enrollment February 1, 2017

District 303 parents and guardians may register their children for Kindergarten for the 2017-2018 school year beginning on **Wednesday, February 1** at all District 303 elementary schools. Register at the elementary school where children in your area currently attend Kindergarten.

Per state law, a child must be five (5) years old on or before September 1, 2017 to be eligible to attend Kindergarten during the 2017-2018 school year. Reliable proof of a child's identity and age (original birth certificate, passport, visa, etc.) will be required at the time of registration as will verification of the identity of the parent or guardian.

Families must provide two (2) documents as proof of residency when enrolling children. Student residency and enrollment information, including links to required notices and Kindergarten enrollment forms, can be found on the District 303 website district.d303.org/enrollment-and-registration.

Parents have the option of an All Day Kindergarten (ADK) or Half Day Kindergarten program. All Day Kindergarten is a tuition-based program. Information regarding All Day Kindergarten tuition for the 2017-2018 school year will be available before February 1, pending Board of Education approval.

D303 Announces 2017-18 Pre-School Program Key Dates

District 303's Early Childhood program is conducting an on-line registration lottery through **Monday, January 23** for preschool classes at Fox Ridge, Ferson Creek and Norton Creek schools. The five-day-a-week, ½ day, morning or afternoon preschool program is open to 3-5 year old children who reside within the D303 school boundaries and who are 3 years old by September 1, 2017. Children who are 5 years old by September 1, 2017 will not be eligible for enrollment.

The tuition cost for the program is \$285* per month. A \$100* annual non-refundable registration and materials fee will also be required. (*Tuition and registration and materials fee are pending Board of Education approval.)

The lottery will take place on Tuesday, January 24 and parents will be notified that day via email if their child was randomly selected. Registrants not chosen will be placed on a waiting list and will be notified if space becomes available. [Click here](#) for more information.

D303 Parent University Presents the Film “Paper Tigers”

Join us for District 303 Parent University when we present the Documentary Film “Paper Tigers” on **Wednesday, January 25** at 7 p.m. in the Norris Cultural Arts Center, 1040 Dunham Rd. in St. Charles. This

screening is being provided in collaboration with the St. Charles Education Association, St. Charles Education Support Professionals, and St. Charles Transportation and Maintenance.

Paper Tigers is an intimate look into the lives of selected students at Lincoln High School, an alternative school that specializes in educating traumatized youth. Set amidst the struggling rural community of Walla Walla, WA, the film intimately examines the inspiring promise of Trauma-Informed Communities - a movement that is showing great promise in healing youth struggling with the dark legacy of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs). Following six students over the course of a school year, the film shows Lincoln’s staff trying a new approach to discipline: one based on understanding and treatment rather than judgment and suspension.
