District 303 utilizes PushCoin to pay for all school activities, including registration, sports, lunch, summer camps and more! If you would like to learn more about PushCoin, visit [www.PushCoin.com](http://www.PushCoin.com). Pushcoin accepts credit/debit card or ACH check payments (for credit/debit card payments a 2.79%+.25 cent processing fee is applied).

One of the most convenient features of PushCoin is that funds can be transferred from one student to another. Therefore, you can add an amount to your account with one transaction from your bank account through eCheck or credit card and then distribute money to your other student's accounts without an additional transaction fee.

What to expect when you use PushCoin?

- PushCoin is a mobile-friendly website. You can use a smartphone or a tablet to fund and monitor your students' lunch accounts.
- You can set up notifications so you'll be alerted when your child makes a purchase or when the account balance is low.
- You can check your child's transaction history.

Families new to the district will be provided a login ID and temporary password for HAC and a registration code for Pushcoin once enrollment is complete and residency has been verified. Please contact your school's office if you need assistance with HAC or Pushcoin.
