St. Charles Community Unit District 303 Set to Destroy Special Education Records

The temporary Special Education records of Community Unit School District 303, St. Charles, are set to be destroyed. Special Education records of students with a date of birth year of 1988-1991, who graduated or transferred out of the district, will be destroyed in July 2016. If a parent or student has reason to believe that these records may be of continued usefulness, they are encouraged to contact the District 303, Department of Instruction, Instructional Interventions, at (331)228-6732, to obtain these records.

Special Education records may include: reports of psychological or social work evaluations, reports of multi-disciplinary planning conferences, reports of annual reviews, copies of individual educational programs, or other verified information of clear relevance to the education of the student. Copies of the Rules and Regulations to Govern District 303 Student Records are available for inspection at each school site and at the District Central Office.

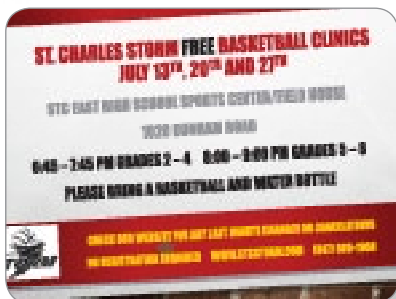
New Video! D303 Wayback Machine - "Pot Hole Day"
