## COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT 303 SCHOOL BOARD VACANCY FILLED

The Community Unit School District 303 School Board is pleased to announce that Mr. Scott Nowling has been appointed to serve on the District 303 School Board. Mr. Nowling previously served as an elected member of the District 303 School Board from 2007-2011, including as Board President from 2009-2011. In addition, Mr. Nowling served as a co-chair of Summit 303 in 2012. His experience as an elected official is an invaluable resource given the short amount of time he will serve as part of this appointment. School Board President Kathy Hewell said, "I am proud of the work the Board has done during this process. This was an extremely difficult decision for the Board. All six of our final candidates have background and experience that would enhance the work of the District.

After over two hours of deliberation reviewing the attributes and contributions of all of the finalists, Mr. Nowling was selected by unanimous vote in open session. "We are excited to have Mr. Nowling join Community Unit School District 303 School Board, and believe that his prior experience and personal qualities will be a welcome addition", said Mrs. Kathleen Hewell, School Board President. He will serve until the new School Board is seated after the April 2, 2019 election.

## UPDATES AT EAST HIGH SCHOOL

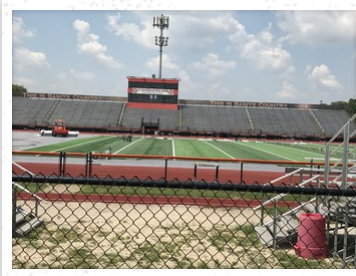
As District 303 gears up for the start of school, one summer construction project at East High School is complete, and one is nearing completion. As part of the enhanced security upgrades to schools in District 303 that currently do not have a two tiered entry system, an additional wall was built inside East High School's main entrance. After announcing themselves, visitors will enter the school and check in at the window to drop off items or gain access to the school.

The second project at East is the installation of a synthetic turf field, which will be completed in time for the Saints' first home football game on September 7 against Glenbard North. The field will not only be used by athletic teams but also physical education classes and the marching band. The surface provides for accessibility well into the fall.
