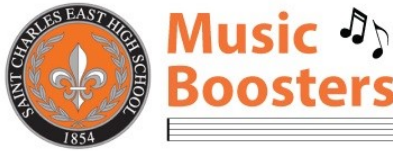
HELP WANTED—MUSICIANS NEEDED

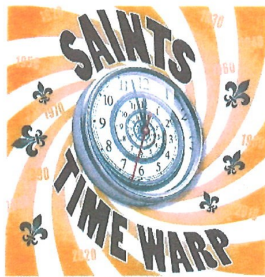

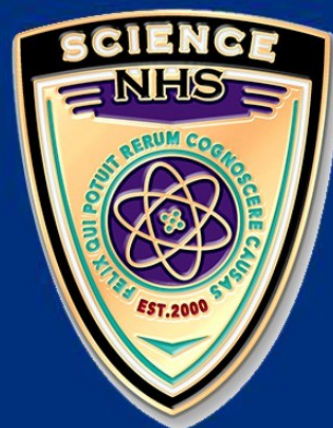

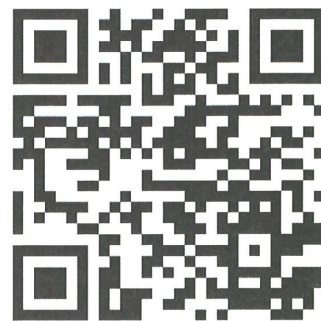
