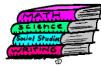

ST. CHARLES PUBLIC LIBRARY PROGRAMS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Financial Aid Process is Tuesday, September 25 at 7:00 p.m. at the St. Charles Public Library. Many students and parents consider finances the biggest barrier to college. This session outlines the financial aid process and provides insight on ways to maximize access to financial aid to help pay for college.
