## *From the Principal*

### **After School Enrichment**

Monday, February 4<sup>th</sup> begins our two-week After School Enrichment program. I want to thank our PTO for orchestrating such awesome experiences for our students. If your child is staying for an ASE event, please send a note for your child's classroom teacher on the date of the course indicating the change in dismissal procedures. Although classroom teachers are well aware of the ASE roster, it is always great to cross-check, and if there are discrepancies, it is beneficial to resolve it in the morning, as opposed to at dismissal.

Also, this year parents are asked to proceed to their child's ASE location and sign them out. A white board will be placed in the lobby area of the school that provides information about the location of your child's enrichment class.

### **Middle School Transfer Requests—5<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent ONLY**

Families who wish to submit Middle School Transfer requests may do so beginning February 4. The request form will be available on the District 303 website through February 28. Families must complete a separate form for each student they want transferred. Requests are granted based on space available so siblings are not guaranteed placement.

Once the request is approved, a student may remain at that middle school throughout his or her middle school career, as long as the student resides in District 303.

Families of students granted permission to attend a school outside of their assigned attendance are responsible for their own transportation.

Students **will** return to their assigned attendance area high school regardless of the middle school attended.

### **Kindergarten Registration**

Kindergarten registration is scheduled for February 6<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 9:30-2:30. If you plan on registering a kindergarten student for the 2019-2020 school year, but are unable to attend on February 6<sup>th</sup>, feel free to stop in the main office any day after February 6<sup>th</sup> to register.

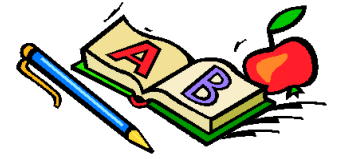

## February 6, 2019

Community Unit School District 303 offers both Half Day and All Day Kindergarten programs. All Day Kindergarten is a fee-based program for the additional 1/2 day of instruction. Information regarding All Day Kindergarten fees can be found on the District website at [district.d303.org](http://district.d303.org) in the Schools menu titled "Kindergarten Information".

The following information is **required** when enrolling for kindergarten\*:

- Reliable proof of child's identity and age (*birth certificate*+, *passport*, *visa*, etc.)
- Verification of Parent/Guardian Identity
- Two documents as proof of residency
- Parcel Identification Number (PIN)

\*New student residency and enrollment information, *including links to required notices and kindergarten enrollment forms*, can be found on the District 303 web site ([district.d303.org/registration](http://district.d303.org/registration)).

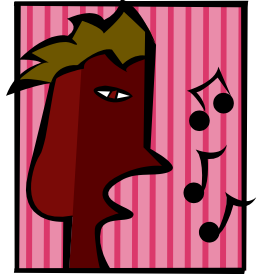

Complete information about physical examinations, dental examinations and immunizations will be available at the February enrollment event. Students are expected to have all requirements completed by the first day of school. Student assignments will be available in August.

- Review the lyrics and theme of the song carefully before submitting your request. **Inappropriate lyrics or "themes" are not permitted in this PTO-sponsored event.** The Lip Sync Committee reserves the right to limit the number of songs from the same movie/show.
- Groups must contain 3 or more performers - no solos or duets.
- Performances must be 2 minutes or less and must have a set up/take down time of two minutes or less. The lip sync is traditionally simple. We are to only use props that we bring in ourselves and can set up and take down in a two minute transition timeframe. Lighting is simple (either full lights or dim lights.) We do not permit the following: glitter, confetti, silly string etc. Please contact Jaime with your prop details.
- There must be one ADULT CONTACT for each group. This adult will submit all registration forms/music, receive information regarding rehearsal, performances, etc. via email and communicate this information to all group members and sit with the group during the show.

**THE DEADLINE FOR REGISTERING AN ACT IS Friday, January 25th.**

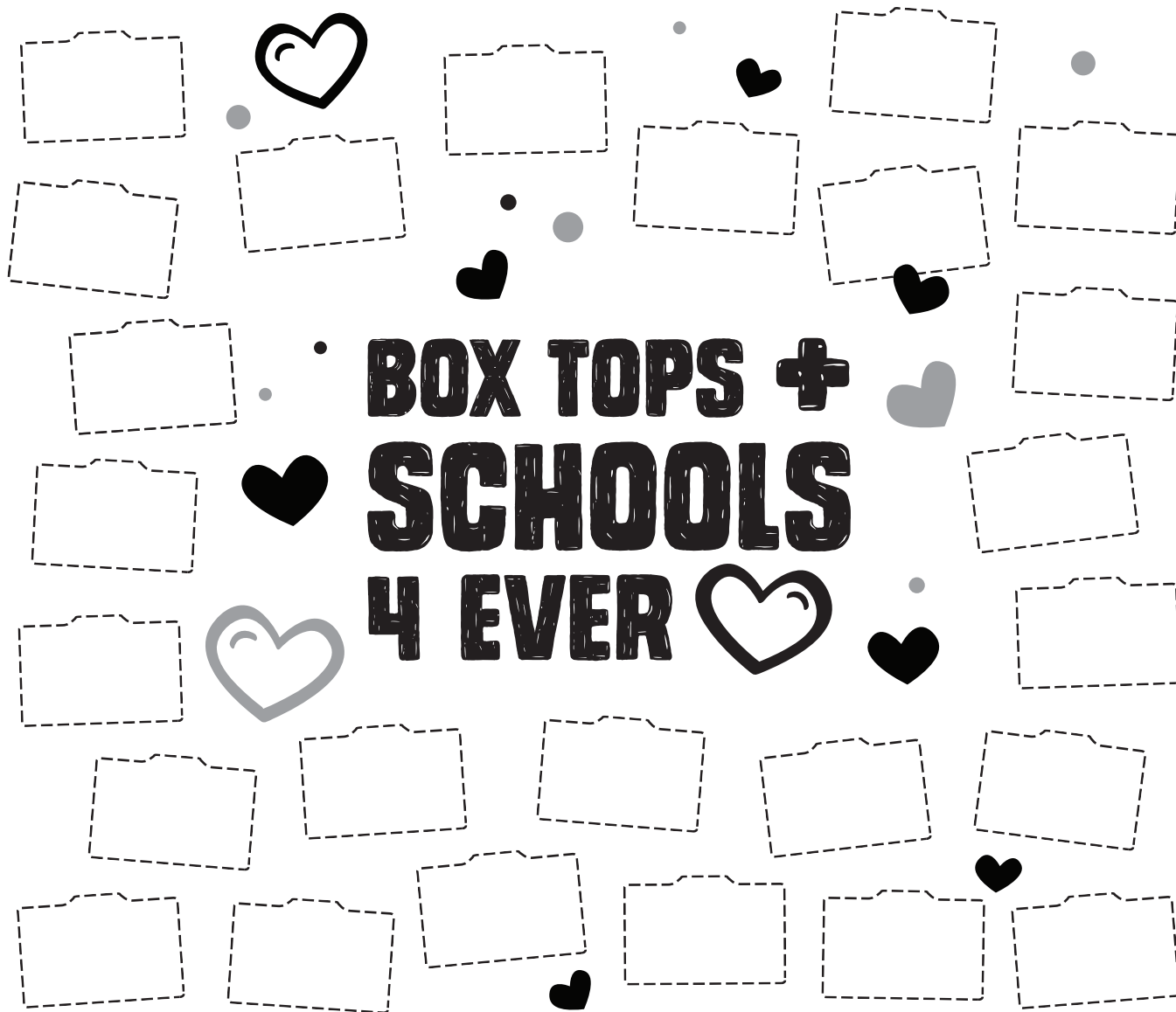
