### District

St. Charles Community Unit School District 303 is a high-achieving, pre-K-12 system covering 57.4 square miles in the picturesque Fox River Valley, 40 miles west of Chicago. District 303 serves approx. 12,000 students from the City of St. Charles and portions of West Chicago, South Elgin, Wayne, Campton Hills, Wasco, Elburn and unincorporated Kane County. District 303 operates 11 elementary school buildings, including one early childhood center, one primary school (K-2), one intermediate school (3-5), two middle schools (6-8), and two high schools.

St. Charles North High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school enrolling 1,894 students in grades 9-12. St. Charles North is fully accredited by the Illinois State Board of Education and holds membership with the College Board and the Illinois Association of College Admissions Counseling.
