Dear Parent:

Between January 7 and January 25, students in grades 3 through 5 will be taking the Performance Series computer adaptive assessment. The test has one section for reading/ELA and one for math, approximately 40-50 minutes each.


Performance Series results will be used by your school and student's teacher(s) as one piece of information about how each student is achieving curriculum standards. Results information is used to adapt and plan for instruction, as well as to look at individual student and groups of student's progress through standards over time. Information is also used as a piece of information for student programming such as Academically Talented.

The results of your child's performance on these tests will be posted in HAC and/or available at your school. We appreciate your support of our academic program and your partnership in facilitating your child's learning.

2019-2020 D303 Preschool Program Lottery Registration

Community Unit School District 303 is conducting on-line lottery registration for its [Community Preschool Program](#) from **January 22 through February 4, 2019**.

For the 2019-2020 school year, District 303 is offering a five-day-a-week, half-day, morning or afternoon preschool program at Fox Ridge or Ferson Creek Schools.

The program will be open to children who reside within the District 303 school boundaries, are between the ages of three and five-years old and are not eligible for Kindergarten.

The Preschool fee for the program is \$285.00* per month. A \$100* annual non-refundable registration and materials fee will also be required. (*Monthly fees and registration/materials fee are pending School Board approval.)

Observational tours will be offered to all D303 community parents prior to registration.

Ferson Creek Tour (38W160 Bolcum Road, St. Charles)

Names will be drawn on February 5, and parents will be notified via email that day if their child was randomly selected. Registrants not chosen will be placed on a waiting list and will be notified if space becomes available. 

Community Unit School District 303 offers both Half Day and All Day Kindergarten programs. All Day Kindergarten is a fee-based program for the additional 1/2 day of instruction. Information regarding All Day Kindergarten fees can be found on the District website at district.d303.org in the Schools menu titled "Kindergarten Information".

The following information is required when enrolling for kindergarten*:

- Reliable proof of child's identity and age (*birth certificate+, passport, visa, etc.*)
- Verification of Parent/Guardian Identity
- Two documents as proof of residency
- Parcel Identification Number (PIN)

**New student residency and enrollment information, including links to required notices and kindergarten enrollment forms, can be found on the District 303 web site (district.d303.org/registration).*

+Required to comply with the Missing Children Records Act [325 ILCS 50/5]

Complete information about physical examinations, dental examinations and immunizations will be available at the February enrollment event. Students are expected to have all requirements completed by the first day of school. Student assignments will be available in August.



Dear Munhall Families:

Greetings! We are writing with exciting news. This month, our school is embarking on a special project, an all school book club called **One School, One Book**. Every family will receive a copy of the same book – Kate DiCamillo’s *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane* -- and asked to read it at home over a 4 week period, January 22nd-February 15th. This book is a gift from the Munhall PTO.

Reading aloud at home is valuable because it better prepares your child to be an effective reader. But it is also a fun, worthwhile family activity. With the **One School, One Book** program, we aim to build a community of readers at our school. Everyone - students, parents, teachers, even administrative staff - will be participating, and we can all reap the many benefits.

Your family will receive his/her copy of *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane* on January 11th via your youngest child at Munhall. When the book comes home, please take a look at the enclosed reading schedule, so you can keep up at home. Generally, you will be asked to read 1-2 chapters a night – about 15 minutes per night. Also included in the schedule are dates for special Friday treats and an end of event picnic dinner at the school.

One School, One Book is a novel program in that children at all grade levels will all be listening to the same book. Strange or daring as that may seem, it actually makes sound educational sense. Reading professionals recommend reading material out loud that is beyond a child’s own reading level. And we also believe that you can and should continue reading chapter books with your older children, even when they are able to read by themselves. We have selected a title that can be followed and understood and enjoyed by younger students, but that will still captivate and stimulate older children. You will want to make sure your family keeps up, so your child can be included. Throughout the month, everyone will be talking about *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane!*

One quick note regarding the content of *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane*: We chose this book because of its broad appeal to a wide range of ages, abilities and interests as well as its messages about kindness, compassion, and resilience. We wanted you to be aware that chapter 17 contains a reference to alcohol. Chapter 19 deals with the death of one of the main characters. Please preview these chapters and address it as you see fit through discussion.

Good luck! “When a whole school reads a book, there’s a lot to talk about.” With your help, we can build a Community of Readers at our school.

- Get a group of friends together, choose a song that fits the theme and add choreography, costumes, and LIP SYNC on the big stage at Norris Cultural Arts Center! (Rehearsal is Wednesday, February 20th.)
- Munhall Student Council chose "Make 'Em Laugh" as this year's theme. This would include songs that fit the category of "Comedy, Funny, and Silly."
- Songs will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Adult contacts can request a song and fill out information at here: <https://munhallpto.membershiptoolkit.com> (See below for more detailed instructions)
- Review the lyrics and theme of the song carefully before submitting your request. **Inappropriate lyrics or "themes" are not permitted in this PTO-sponsored event.** The Lip Sync Committee reserves the right to limit the number of songs from the same movie/show.
- Groups must contain 3 or more performers - no solos or duets.
- Performances must be 2 minutes or less and must have a set up/take down time of two minutes or less. The lip sync is traditionally simple. We are to only use props that we bring in ourselves and can set up and take down in a two minute transition timeframe. Lighting is simple (either full lights or dim lights.) We do not permit the following: glitter, confetti, silly string etc. Please contact Jaime with your prop details.
- There must be one ADULT CONTACT for each group. This adult will submit all registration forms/music, receive information regarding rehearsal, performances, etc. via email and communicate this information to all group members and sit with the group during the show.

THE DEADLINE FOR REGISTERING AN ACT IS Friday, January 25th.

Here's how to register and request a song:

Registration is easy! You must have an account on the PTO website. Go to <https://munhallpto.membershiptoolkit.com/form/m/64539> and fill out the information in the form. Jaime will email the official "approval" within 48 hours of your request. Your song selection is not approved until you get a confirmation email.

Munhall Lip Sync - Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is the Lip Sync?

A. The Lip Sync is a PTO-sponsored event that gives Munhall students a chance to perform on the “big stage” in a fun, non-competitive environment. Groups choreograph and perform a two-minute lip sync to a song that fits the theme. Costumes and props are encouraged.

Q. Who participates in the Lip Sync?

A. All Munhall students are welcome to participate.

Q. What is the theme this year?

A. “Make ‘Em Laugh!”- comedy, funny, silly songs.

Q. Can my child do a Lip Sync alone?

A. Unfortunately, no. This is a “group” event. An act must have at least 3 participants. There is no limit to the number of performers in a group (as long as they all fit on the stage).

Q. Can my child be in more than one Lip Sync Act?

A. Yes! Your child may participate with up to 3 different groups (ex. classroom act, Student Council, group of friends). If your child is in more than one act, be sure you tell the adult contact as it will impact the dress rehearsal schedule and order of acts for the show.

Q. Does it cost anything to participate in a Lip Sync act?

A. No - performers get to watch the show for free too!

Q. How do I get tickets for the Lip Sync? Are there assigned seats?

A. Tickets will go on sale on the PTO website (<https://munhallpto.membershiptoolkit.com/form/m/64538>) on Feb 17th at 8 AM through 9 PM on Feb 19th for performer's families with a 6 ticket limit per family. **YOU MUST HAVE A PTO ACCOUNT TO PURCHASE TICKETS.** Tickets are sold and seats are assigned on a first come, first served basis. The Norris Cultural Arts Center auditorium has long rows of seats with no center aisle. There is elevator-accessible seating in the balcony and limited wheelchair accessible seating in both the main floor and balcony. It is critical that you order tickets early if you have specific needs for seating. This show historically SELLS OUT! Purchase your tickets as soon as they are available.

Q. I don't know how to edit music. Is there someone who can do this for me?

A. Jaime is happy to edit your music for you if needed. Email her with your information such as: song title, artist, and if you know the specific 2 minute section of the song you'd like.

Q. I still have questions about the Lip Sync. Who should I contact?

A. Last year 195 students participated in the Lip Sync. Ask around - friends, neighbors, and teachers - they'll be a great source of information. Feel free to contact Jaime Sjogren with general questions and/or questions regarding music editing. Jaime Sjogren drdance@sbcglobal.net
