Electric Christmas Parade Grand Marshals Announced Special Olympians of St. Charles to be Honored

ST. CHARLES, IL - The Downtown St. Charles Partnership (DSCP) is pleased to announce local athletes of Special Olympics Illinois have been selected as the Grand Marshals for the 2018 Electric Christmas Parade, which will take place at 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 25 on Main Street in Downtown St. Charles.

In honor of Special Olympics celebrating their 50th Anniversary, we invited Special Olympians in St. Charles to represent them as our 2018 Grand Marshals. Representing Special Olympics of Illinois will be athletes of different ages from School District 303 and Fox Valley Special Recreation Association.

We are excited to have recent St. Charles East High School graduate Christopher Chavez, who took home 2 gold and 2 silver medals at the USA Games held in Seattle this past July. He received his 2 gold medals in the 100 meter dash and long jump and his silver medals in javelin throw and team 4x100 meter relay.

Another athlete – 15-year-old Kylie Langland - participates in bowling, bocce and track & field, and will also be there to represent Special Olympics of Illinois. Kylie and her family have lived in St. Charles for 13 years. Kylie's mother, Sharon Langland, said "without St. Charles District 303; Kylie would not be where she is today! The compassion exhibited by Kylie's team is nothing short of exceptional!"

"It gives my family great pride to be a part of Special Olympics and be able to represent such a wonderful organization," Sharon also said. "The ability to be Grand Marshals will promote further awareness for all children and adults with special needs. It allows the City of St. Charles and all surrounding communities to see what this amazing organization can offer!"

Jennifer Payne, mother of Grant Sturgeon, a basketball and running star who participates with Fox Valley Special Recreation Association, said "as a parent, it means community awareness and acceptance. Many businesses in this community have embraced individuals with special needs and discovered valuable employees in the process. As athletes, the effort given at every event is 110% of what they thought they were capable of giving. It is so inspiring!"

The Electric Christmas Parade is organized by the DSCP, along with the help of many volunteers. The DSCP Executive Director Jenna Sawicki said "we are incredibly happy to have members of Special Olympics Illinois be our grand marshals this year. This means a lot to us, but I'm sure it means even more to them."
