A wise person once said, "Worry is the greatest thief of joy." I will add to that (Although, I would hardly call myself wise.): Worry is also the greatest thief of the moment. It not only robs us of moments we could spend doing more positive, productive, enjoyable activities, but it also steals us away from the people we love the most when we should be sharing moments with them. Those things will get done and are all important, but nothing is more important than those moments. It can be so easy to get pulled out of them, but when we remain mindful, we make memories that will last a lifetime filling us with joy, gratitude, and resilience for the journey ahead.

MIDDLE SCHOOL TRANSFER REQUESTS FOR 5TH, 6TH, AND 7TH GRADE STUDENTS

Families who wish to submit Middle School Transfer requests may do so beginning February 4. The request form will be available on the District 303 website through February 28. Families must complete a separate form for each student they want transferred. Requests are granted based on space available so siblings are not guaranteed placement.

Once the request is approved, a student may remain at that middle school throughout his or her middle school career, as long as the student resides in District 303.

Families of students granted permission to attend a school outside of their assigned attendance are responsible for their own transportation.

Students **will** return to their assigned attendance area high school regardless of the middle school attended.

If you know of anyone who is new to our school district with a kindergarten age student and has not yet registered their Kindergarten student, please share this important information about Kindergarten Enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year. They will need to contact the office to set up a registration time. Thank you.



Kindergarten Enrollment
February 6, 2019



If your child will be 5-years old on or before September 1, 2019
it's time to register for kindergarten.

DO NOT WAIT until summer to enroll your new kindergarten student. Kindergarten enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year will be at all Community Unit School District 303 elementary schools on **February 6**. Enroll at the elementary school where children in your area currently attend.

Community Unit School District 303 offers both Half Day and All Day Kindergarten programs. All Day Kindergarten is a fee-based program for the additional 1/2 day of instruction. Information regarding All Day Kindergarten fees can be found on the District website at district.d303.org in the Schools menu titled "Kindergarten Information".

The following information is **required** when enrolling for kindergarten*:

- Reliable proof of child's identity and age (birth certificate+, passport, visa, etc.)
- Verification of Parent/Guardian Identity
- Two documents as proof of residency
- Parcel Identification Number (PIN)

Birth Certificate must be the county issued certified copy.

*New student residency and enrollment information. **including links to required notices and kindergarten enrollment forms**, can be found on the District 303 web site (district.d303.org/registration)

+Required to comply with the Missing Children Records Act [325 ILCS 50/5]

Complete information about physical examinations, dental examinations and immunizations will be available at the February enrollment event. Students are expected to have all requirements completed by the first day of school. Student assignments will be available in August.

*****Preferred Proof of residency: Recent utility bill (gas, electric or water) and recent property tax bill**
