## ATHLETIC BOOSTERS - SCHOLARSHIP

The STC East Athletic Boosters have voted to increase the scholarships they offer to graduating seniors for the class of 2019. This year, the Boosters will select five (5) winners and each chosen winner will receive \$1,500 toward their college or vocational tuition!

To be eligible, the student must have participated in at least two years of a sport or sport support activity, be in the top 1/2 of their class and NOT be receiving a full-ride athletic scholarship. Also, to be eligible, the student's parent or guardian must be a Booster Member in good standing. More details can be found within the application itself. The deadline for this scholarship application is Wednesday, April 3, 2019 - no exceptions. ## AP TESTING

Here is some important information for students who are interested in taking an AP exam but are not enrolled in the corresponding AP course:

AP Testing is May 6-17, 2019. All students who are enrolled in an AP course are already registered to take the corresponding exam. If you are interested in taking an AP exam for a course in which you are not enrolled, please pick up a registration form from the Student Services Office. Students must register and pay for additional exams by March 1<sup>st</sup>. The cost of EACH exam you register to take is \$94.00. If the total payment is not received by Thursday, March 1, the test(s) will not be ordered. Please note this only pertains to AP exams for courses in which you are not currently enrolled.

All students who register to take an Advanced Placement test must attend a mandatory Pre-Administration session to begin the preliminary AP testing paperwork. Pre-Administration sessions will be held in April. More information will follow regarding times and room location.
