5th-Grade Band Members



Students will enjoy many outdoor/indoor activities. For the day's activities, they will need to be dressed comfortably with tennis-type shoes. If you believe that your child will need sunscreen for field day, please apply it at home before sending your child to school. You may want to give consideration to using a product that has a longer duration and continuous coverage. Also, please send a filled water bottle labeled with your child's first and last name.

To ensure the success of Field Day we rely on the outstanding support from our parent/guardian volunteers. We need volunteers to run games for either all day or just morning and afternoon sessions. Your job will include working with other parent volunteers to lead the Field Day games. This year we will be utilizing the website VolunteerSpot to organize our volunteers. Please note that our volunteer opportunities are limited and are on a first come basis. **The activities on VolunteerSpot are listed by grade levels and time. For the purpose of this sign-up, grade 0 represents Kindergarten.**

Since Field Day is a special day for Munhall students, please make childcare arrangements for younger siblings.
