

## **Coyote Tales Vol. 20**

Earlier today I sent out a text blast asking parents not to park in the inner part of the bus circle. While we have made this request before, parents continue to park there. I'd like to explain our reasoning for making this request.

As students are walking to their cars (with or without an adult), they are being put into a potentially dangerous situation. Cars are moving in and out of the circle constantly. Walking between two parked cars is unsafe. Even with an adult, it is not a good practice. We need to remember that children are always watching and learning from us. If we model that it's ok to walk between two parked cars at school, they learn that it's ok to do this anywhere. It is never safe to walk into an area of traffic coming from between two parked cars. Too many tragedies happen this way.

Many parents have complained that there is no where to park and this is why they choose this location. I would encourage parents to wait in line with the cars if you can't find a place to park. Our pick up time is one of the fastest in the district, even with all the cars we have. I promise that we will keep multiple staff members out with the students until all parents have arrived to pick them up. Waiting a few extra minutes in line is worth preventing a tragedy.

Please follow these expectations so that we can keep our Corron children (and adults) safe at all times!

### **Middle School Transfer Requests**

Families who wish to submit Middle School Transfer requests may do so beginning February 4. The request form will be available on the District 303 website through February 28. Families must complete a separate form for each student they want transferred. Requests are granted based on space available so siblings are not guaranteed placement.

Once the request is approved, a student may remain at that middle school throughout his or her middle school career, as long as the student resides in District 303.

Families of students granted permission to attend a school outside of their assigned attendance are responsible for their own transportation.

Students **will** return to their assigned attendance area high school regardless of the middle school attended.

### **2019-2020 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION - SEE ATTACHED**

District 303 parents and guardians may register their children for Kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school year on **Wednesday, February 6, 2019** at all District 303 elementary schools. Please register at the elementary school where children in your area currently attend Kindergarten.

Per state law, a child must be five (5) years old on or before September 1, 2019 to be eligible to attend Kindergarten during the 2019-2020 school year. Reliable proof of a child's identity and age (birth certificate, passport, visa, etc.) will be required at the time of registration as will verification of the identity of the parent or guardian.

In addition, families must provide two (2) documents as proof of residency when enrolling children. New student residency and enrollment information, including links to required notices and Kindergarten enrollment forms, can be found on the District 303 website --> [\*\*Kindergarten Registration Documents\*\*](#).

Parents have the option of an All Day Kindergarten (ADK) or Half Day Kindergarten program. All Day Kindergarten is a fee-based program.
