TIME TO FEED THE GREEN MACHINE

Lincoln Brownie Troop #368 would like your help to Feed the Green Machine. We have partnered with the St. Charles Park District and several other St. Charles schools and S.C.A.R.C.E. to Feed the Green Machine.

So we need your help to recycle your school supplies so they do not end up in landfills at the end of the school year. The gently used items we collect will be sorted and then distributed by S.C.A.R.C.E. to schools in need throughout the Chicagoland area and beyond. We will be taking *all new, gently used and used* items for this collection. The items we will be collecting are.....

WRITING UTENSILS

This means anything that writes even if the marker is dried out. We will sort the writing utensils into working and non-working piles. Working pens and markers will get a new home and dried out pens and markers will be recycled. Stubs of crayons are melted down into rubbing crayons and useable ones that will go to another child.

PAPER

We are looking for anything that you think is useful, post-it notes, the half of the note-book that is not used, kids' magazines, part of the pack of construction paper...try to get the kids to recycle the things that would be considered scrap paper.

GLUE

We need glue sticks that are working or have a bit of glue on the bottom. S.C.A.R.C.E. will combine them into full bottles.

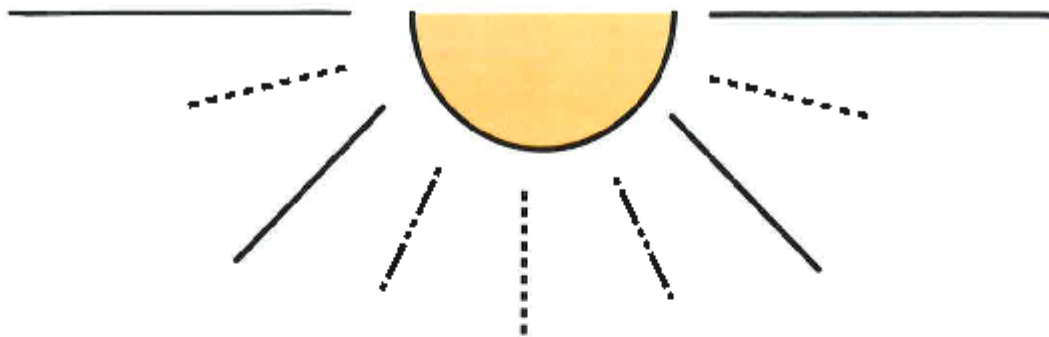
