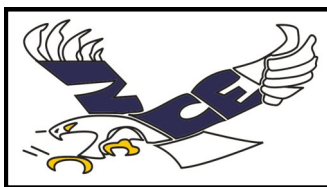

## **From the Principal.....Tony White**

Kristin Souers and Pete Hall are two people I have never had the pleasure of meeting, but am proud to say they have taught me a ton about behavior and resilience. For years, I have thought I was doing it "right" by working to eliminate poor behavioral choices. However, what Souers and Hall teach us in their books "Fostering Resilient Learners" and their latest, "Relationship, Responsibility, and Regulation," is that focusing on eliminating misbehaviors may eliminate the behavior, but a new undesired behavior will pop up. Their mantra is: Every behavior is an expression of need. Last week, we learned a bit about physical needs. This week, let's talk a bit about emotional needs.

There are several ways to look at the brain, and today we will divide into the "upstairs" and "downstairs" brain. The "upstairs brain" is where we access thinking, imagining, and planning. It's the part of the brain we use for critical thinking, problem-solving, and decision-making. The "downstairs brain" is where we find "fight or flight." "Fight or flight" is important for keeping us alive as it triggers any time we feel unsafe. However, it can also leave our brains feeling unregulated until we calm down. This is when undesired behaviors may start to occur.

It is important to note that if the "downstairs brain" is activated...nothing is getting "upstairs." These moments can be challenging for us as the caring adults (and let's not forget for the child too) because of the behaviors that come along with them. We have to teach the child in moments like these how to identify their feelings, get their bodies calm, and alternative methods of dealing with these feelings.

The timing of this work is critical. We know we cannot talk to anyone when they are feeling like this - nothing is getting "upstairs." We also cannot say that a child is too young and will never get it. We have to wait until they have calmed down enough for the message to get "upstairs," but not so long that the recency of the moment is lost. Tricky stuff to be sure when we have a whirlwind of life going on around us, but also some of the most wildly important work we have to do as caring adults.
