This week your child will be bringing home an envelope that contains the results from their recent Performance Series Reading and Math



Assessment. This assessment is given three times per year and helps us identify students strengths and areas of needed growth. We administer this assessment to all students, Kindergarten through 5th Grade, so we can track their progress from year to year as they learn through elementary school. Performance Series Assessment Results Explained

Erins Law

The information here and links below are to inform you about Erin's Law, an Illinois law that requires public schools to provide a prevention-oriented child sexual abuse program in grades PreK-12. Named after sexual abuse survivor Erin Merryn, Erin's Law will be implemented again this year in all District 303 Schools utilizing the Child Protection Unit of the Second Step resource.



Between now and the end of the school year, several lessons will be facilitated by Mrs. Yatchak (School Social Worker) along with the classroom teacher. The lessons will address identifying safe and unsafe touch, private body part rules, and learning ways to stay safe.
