## STUDENT PARKING 2022-23



Many students have the desire to receive a parking pass to park on campus, but every year there are more parking pass requests than available parking spaces. Students wanting a parking pass need to fill out an application form – [LINK](#). However, submitting a parking pass application by any date does not guarantee a parking pass. **All applications submitted by the due date will be entered into an initial lottery to assign passes. Meeting the due date is the best chance to receive a pass.**

Applications submitted after the due date will be entered into a second lottery after Materials Pick-Up days (should any passes remain). Every year, parking passes are not claimed during Materials Pick-Up days and within the first few weeks of school may become available. Furthermore, students leave STCE throughout the school year, and some graduate in December. If parking passes become available at various points throughout the school year, families will be notified.

Seniors and Juniors enrolled in academic-related programs (ECC Education to Careers Program/Principles of Technology, CO-OP, Teaching and Learning Practicum, Internships, and BNAT or Cosmetology through Fox Valley Career Center) will be given priority for an Everyday Pass given the transportation requirements of their STCE-related academic program. All other Seniors are eligible for an everyday pass (\$200), and Juniors are eligible for either an ODD or EVEN parking pass (\$75) for the Range. The Range will be closed for one month in the fall and one month in the spring. Students will then have to make other arrangements for transportation to and from school or take the bus provided by District 303. The ODD/EVEN parking pass fee is prorated accordingly. Some years, Seniors who do not receive an Everyday parking pass may receive an ODD and EVEN pass if the demand for parking passes allows.

Given the size of our student population, not every student who desires a parking pass will be issued one. STCE administration understands that each student/family has unique needs and challenges that can be potentially assisted by the ability for a student to receive a parking pass. However, we cannot prioritize the needs of our students/families, and therefore, the best way to obtain a parking pass is to ensure your application for a parking pass is submitted by the due date – Thursday, July 14, 2022.

Sophomores are not eligible to apply for parking passes. If a sophomore is found parking on campus during the 2022-23 school year, they may become ineligible to apply for a pass junior year. Every year there are more parking pass requests from Juniors and Seniors than available parking spaces, so Sophomores are not eligible for parking passes.

In late July/early August, you will receive a confirmation email from Mr. Shawn Burke regarding parking. If a parking pass will be issued to you, a parent/student signature form will be sent to you to fill out and return on Materials Pick up days and a charge will be made to your PushCoin account. Everyday passes are \$200. ODD/EVEN passes are \$75. Once your payment has been made through PushCoin and the parent/student signature form has been turned into Mr. Burke at Materials Pick Up, you will receive your pass. Continue to watch your D303 student email for updates in August.

##### **STATION 1—STUDENT PLANNER & LANYARD**

Pick-up your School ID and Planner here. A new lanyard will be waiting for you too. No pictures will be taken this week—school pictures will be scheduled in October. More information will follow about school pictures.

**VOTER REGISTRATION**—Seniors—stop by on August 2 or August 8 to complete the paperwork!

##### **STATION 2—HOMECOMING INFORMATION**

Student and parent signatures are needed on the Homecoming Waiver if you plan to participate in the parade, float building, spirit assemblies, etc. Waivers will be available to take home.

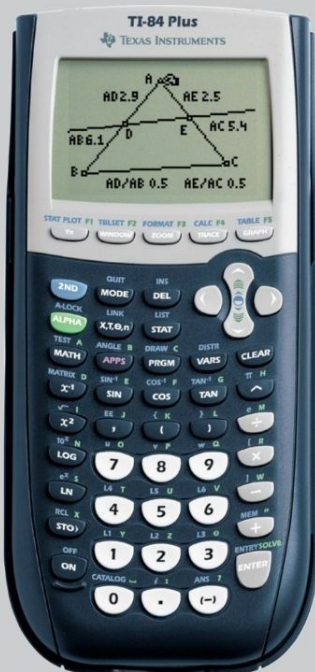

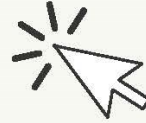

# Returning Student Online Registration



Returning Student Registration for 2022-2023 will open at 9:00 a.m. on April 25. All acknowledgments and authorizations are contained in a single electronic, online registration form that will be easily accessible from most electronic devices (computer, Chromebook, and Smartphones). Please refer to the parent guide located on the web page for detailed instructions on how to complete the form.

Beginning April 25, parents can sign into the Returning Student Online Registration form located in the Parents/Community menu of the District website. Parents/guardians will use their Home Access Center (HAC) credentials to sign in and select individual students to complete each registration.

The electronic registration forms for elementary and middle school students should be completed by June 1. High School online registration forms should be completed no later than July 1.

Registration fees for all grades will be available in Pushcoin beginning July 5, and will be billed to reflect the early bird discount if paid by July 29. Pushcoin will email invoices for accounts with balances due on the 15th of each month until paid in full.

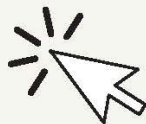
For families who may qualify for a fee waiver, and are not directly certified by the state, a 2022-2023 District Fee Waiver Application will be available on the District 303 website in July, accessible from the Parent/Community menu.

# Información de Inscripción en Línea



La Inscripción para Estudiantes que Regresan para el 2022-2023 abrirá el 25 de abril a las 9:00 a.m. Todos los acuses de recibo y autorizaciones ahora se encuentran en un único formulario de inscripción electrónico en línea que puede ser fácilmente accesible desde la mayoría de los dispositivos electrónicos (computadora, Chromebook, y teléfonos inteligentes). Por favor, consulte la guía para padres que se encuentra en la página web para obtener instrucciones detalladas sobre cómo completar el formulario.

Comenzando el 25 de abril, los padres pueden ingresar al Formulario Electrónico de Inscripción para Estudiantes que Regresan bajo el menú de Padres/Comunidad en el sitio web del Distrito. Los padres/guardianes deberán usar sus credenciales del Centro de Acceso para el Hogar (HAC) y seleccionar a cada estudiante de manera individual para completar su inscripción.

Los formularios de inscripción en línea de los estudiantes de primaria y secundaria deberán completarse antes del 1° de junio. Los formularios de inscripción en línea de los estudiantes de preparatoria deberán completarse a más tardar el 1 de julio.

Las cuotas de inscripción para todos los grados estarán disponibles en PushCoin comenzando el 5 de julio y se hará la cuenta a deber que refleje el descuento de inscripción temprana si se paga para el 29 de julio. El sistema de PushCoin enviará por correo electrónico las facturas de las cuentas con saldos vencidos el día 15 de cada mes hasta que se paguen en su totalidad.

Para las familias que pueden calificar para una exención de tasas, y no están directamente certificadas por el estado, estará disponible una aplicación para la exención de tasas del Distrito para el 2022-2023 en el sitio web del Distrito 303 en julio. Igualmente, esta aplicación se podrá acceder mediante el menú de Padres/Comunidad.

Para los estudiantes que entran al 6° y 9° grado se requiere un comprobante de examen físico antes del primer día de clases. Por favor, visite la página web de servicios de salud del Distrito 303 para más información.
