### *From the Principal...*

Today marks the last day of the second trimester for our elementary schools. As we head into the third trimester, I thought I would share some updates regarding our Social Emotional goal for our building. Our focus has been on providing and supporting students with identifying and using calming strategies when they are anxious or upset. We were able to collect information over the past few weeks to see if the work we are doing with students is having an impact. I've summarized the results below:

Grade level	Fall 2018 Percentage of students who identified <u>2 or more calming strategies</u>	Winter 2019 Percentage of students who identified <u>2 or more calming strategies</u>
Kindergarten	22%	96%
First Grade	37%	93%
Second Grade	76%	99%
Third Grade	70%	87%
Fourth Grade	57%	89%
Fifth Grade	40%	48%

We are so impressed with the skills that students are developing to help them self-regulate their emotions and problem-solve tricky situations. Just this week, I heard a kindergarten student talking about a difficult situation at recess. In the past, he would typically cry or shut down. His response this time was, "I guess I just have to let it bounce off of me!". He even used a hand motion represented a ball bouncing off of his stomach. Such wisdom from a five year-old!
