HIGH SCHOOL

Returning Student Registration for 2020-2021 has moved to an online format that opened on April 27, 2020. In years past, parents completed the necessary paperwork in paper format. This year, all acknowledgments and authorizations are contained in a single electronic, online registration form that is easily accessible from most electronic devices (computer, Chromebook, and Smartphones). Guardians should log in using their Home Access Center (HAC) login ID and password. If you do not know your HAC login ID and/or password, please contact the school office for assistance. There is a Parent Guide to Online Registration with step-by-step instructions in the Parents/Community menu of the District website.

High School fees will be available on June 1, 2020. Please pay your students fees on PushCoin by July 15, 2020 to take advantage of the early bird discount. PushCoin is accessible in the Parents/Community menu of the District website under the Webstore/PushCoin heading. **No parking fees, sports fees or course specific fees are being collected at this time.**

New for 2020-2021 CUSD 303 Fee Waiver & NSLP Food Waiver Applications. All students are charged the regular registration fees. In July, if your family is directly certified by the State as receiving SNAP, TANF or Foster Care benefits the fees will be adjusted to zero. If your family is not directly certified by the State, you will need to complete the paper CUSD 303 Fee Waiver Application and submit that with the required financial documentation to the D303 Business Office to see if you qualify for a fee waiver. These paper applications will be accessible from the Parent/Community menu on the district website under the Fee Waiver heading.

You will also need to complete an online NSLP food waiver application during the month of July if you wish your student to receive free lunches. This online application will be accessible from the Parent/Community menu on the district website under the Food Services heading, Free and Reduced Meals section.





INSCRIPCIÓN DE LA ESCUELA PREPARATORIA D303 2020-21

La inscripción para estudiantes que regresan para el 2020-2021 se ha movido a un formato en línea que se abrió el 27 de abril de 2020. En años pasados, los padres completaron el papeleo necesario en formato de papel. Este año, todos los reconocimientos y autorizaciones están contenidos en un único formulario de registro electrónico en línea al que se puede acceder fácilmente desde la mayoría de los dispositivos electrónicos (computadora, Chromebook y Smartphones). Los tutores deben iniciar la sesión utilizando su identificación de inicio de sesión y contraseña del Centro de Acceso al Hogar (HAC). Si usted no sabe su ID de ingreso a HAC y/o su contraseña, por favor contacte a la oficina de la escuela para obtener ayuda. Hay una Guía para Padres para la Inscripción en línea con instrucciones paso a paso en el menú Padres/Comunidad del sitio web del Distrito.

Las cuotas de la escuela preparatoria estarán disponibles el 1 de junio de 2020. Por favor paguen las cuotas de sus estudiantes en PushCoin antes del 15 de julio de 2020 para aprovechar el descuento de inscripción temprana. PushCoin está accesible en el menú de Padres/Comunidad del sitio web del Distrito bajo el título Webstore/ PushCoin. **No se cobran tarifas de estacionamiento, deportes o cursos específicos en este momento.**

Nuevo para el 2020-2021 CUSD 303 Solicitudes de Exención de Tarifas y Exención de Alimentos NSLP. A todos los estudiantes se les cobra la cuota de inscripción regular. En julio, si el Estado certifica directamente que su familia recibe beneficios de SNAP, TANF o Foster Care, las cuotas se ajustarán a cero. Si su familia no está certificada directamente por el Estado, tendrá que completar la Solicitud de Exención de Tarifas CUSD 303 en papel y presentarla con la documentación financiera requerida a la Oficina de Negocios D303 para ver si califica para una exención de tarifas. Estas solicitudes en papel serán accesibles desde el menú Padre/Comunidad en el sitio web del distrito bajo el encabezado de Exención de Tarifas.

También tendrá que completar una solicitud de exención de alimentos NSLP en línea durante el mes de julio si desea que su estudiante reciba almuerzos gratuitos. Esta solicitud en línea será accesible desde el menú para padres/comunidad en el sitio web del distrito bajo el título de Servicios Alimenticios, sección de Comidas Gratis y Reducidas.
