Student Information Letter for 2019-2020 Class Placement

Therefore, balancing classrooms based on gender, special needs or talents, learning styles, and personalities are all factored as we compile class lists. We welcome any information that you would like to provide about your student in order to assist us in making the best possible placement. Because of the many factors considered when putting a class roster together, requests for specific teachers will not be accepted. Clearly defining the needs of your child will be most helpful in making a good classroom assignment.

If you have information that will assist us in making a placement for your child, please forward that information to me in writing. You may wish to include the following types of information:

- Your child's talents and needs*

- The type of classroom environment that has been or will be most beneficial for your child*

- Your child's personality and learning style*

- If granted, transportation is the responsibility of the parents.
- The transfer is for one school year and will require re-application the following school year.


