STATION 1—STUDENT PLANNER & LANYARD

Pick-up your ID and Planner here. A new lanyard will be waiting for you too. No pictures will be taken this week—school pictures will be scheduled in October. More information will follow about school pictures.

STATION 2—HOMECOMING INFORMATION

Preliminary planning for Homecoming will be shared. Student and parent signatures are needed on the Homecoming Waiver if you plan to participate in the parade, float building, spirit assemblies, etc. Waivers will be available to take home.

Returning Student Online Registration



Returning Student Registration for 2021-2022 will open at 9:00 a.m. on April 26. All acknowledgments and authorizations are contained in a single electronic, online registration form that will be easily accessible from most electronic devices (computer, Chromebook, and Smartphones). Please refer to the parent guide located on the web page for detailed instructions on how to complete the form.

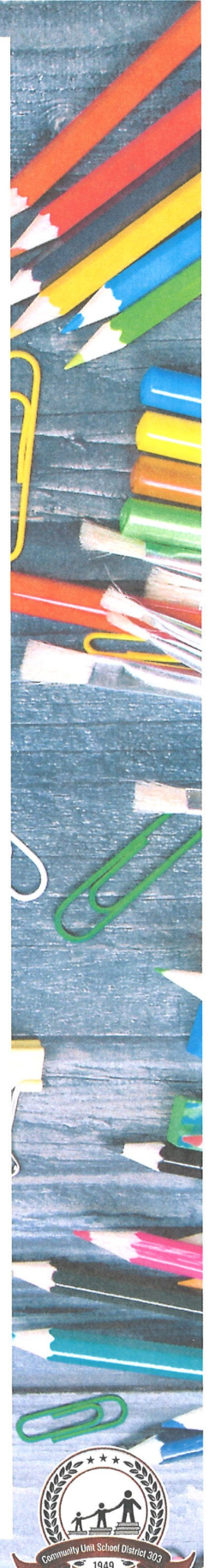
Beginning April 26, parents can sign into the **Returning Student Online Registration** form located in the **Parents/Community menu** of the District website. Parents/guardians will use their Home Access Center (HAC) credentials to sign in and select individual students to complete each registration.

The electronic registration forms for elementary and middle school students should be completed by June 1. High School online registration forms should be completed no later than July 1.

Registration fees for all grades will be available in Pushcoin beginning July 1, and will be billed to reflect the early bird discount if paid by July 31. Pushcoin will email invoices for accounts with balances due on the 15th of each month until paid in full.

For families who may qualify for a fee waiver, and are not directly certified by the state, a 2021-2022 district fee waiver application will be available on the District 303 website in July, accessible from the Parent/Community menu.

Students entering sixth and ninth grades require proof of a physical exam prior to the first day of school. Please visit the District 303 [health services web page](#) for more information.



Información de Inscripción en Línea



La **Inscripción para Estudiantes que Regresan para el 2021-2022** abrirá el 26 de abril a las 9:00 a.m. Todos los acuses de recibo y autorizaciones ahora se encuentran en un único formulario de inscripción electrónico en línea que puede ser fácilmente accesible desde la mayoría de los dispositivos electrónicos (computadora, Chromebook, y teléfonos inteligentes). Por favor, consulte la guía para padres que se encuentra en la página web para obtener instrucciones detalladas sobre cómo completar el formulario.

Comenzando el 26 de abril, los padres pueden ingresar al **Formulario Electrónico de Inscripción para Estudiantes que Regresan** bajo el menú de **Padres/Comunidad** en el sitio web del Distrito. Los padres/guardianes deberán usar sus credenciales del Centro de Acceso para el Hogar (HAC) y seleccionar a cada estudiante de manera individual para completar su inscripción.

Los formularios de inscripción en línea de los estudiantes de primaria y secundaria deberán completarse antes del 1º de junio. Los formularios de inscripción en línea de los estudiantes de preparatoria deberán completarse a más tardar el 1 de julio.

Las cuotas de inscripción para todos los grados estarán disponibles en PushCoin comenzando el 1º de julio y se hará la cuenta a deber que refleje el descuento de inscripción temprana si se paga para el 31 de julio. El sistema de PushCoin enviará por correo electrónico las facturas de las cuentas con saldos vencidos el día 15 de cada mes hasta que se paguen en su totalidad.

Para las familias que pueden calificar para una exención de tasas, y no están directamente certificadas por el estado, estará disponible una aplicación para la exención de tasas del Distrito para el 2021-2022 en el sitio web del Distrito 303 en Julio. Igualmente, esta aplicación se podrá acceder mediante el menú de Padres/Comunidad.
