Thank you to all of the parents who were able to attend our Curriculum Nights. As I shared at my presentation, families are an important part of our community! Every decision we make as a staff will be anchored in our vision statement:

Corron is a safe, warm, and inviting community where all are valued and empowered. We celebrate growth. Clear evidence highlights the impact we have academically, socially, and emotionally.

One part of safety is knowing what to do in an emergency. This past Tuesday, we were able to practice all of our safety drills as a building (fire, severe weather, and lock down). For each drill, all students were where they needed to be and accounted for within 4 ½ minutes - impressive for a building of 500 students! Please follow up with your child at home to review procedures and expectations for these situations at home, too.

Another aspect of safety is keeping our children safe upon arrival and dismissal. We still have many unsafe situations during these times due to adults not following our procedures. Please review the attached expectations so we can ensure that our students and parents stay safe.
