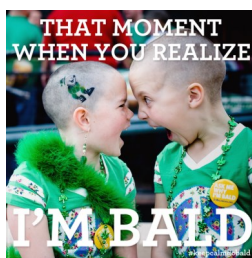

### **ATHLETIC BOOSTERS - SCHOLARSHIP**



The STC East Athletic Boosters have voted to increase the scholarships they offer to graduating seniors for the class of 2019. This year, the Boosters will select five (5) winners and each chosen winner will receive \$1,500 toward their college or vocational tuition!

To be eligible, the student must have participated in at least two years of a sport or sport support activity, be in the top 1/2 of their class and NOT be receiving a full-ride athletic scholarship. Also, to be eligible, the student's parent or guardian must be a Booster Member in good standing. More details can be found within the application itself. The deadline for this scholarship application is Wednesday, April 3, 2019 - no exceptions. ### **PTO SCHOLARSHIP**

The PTO will be granting four \$1,000 scholarships to graduating Seniors who plan to continue their education at a university, junior college or vocational school and whose parents are PTO members. 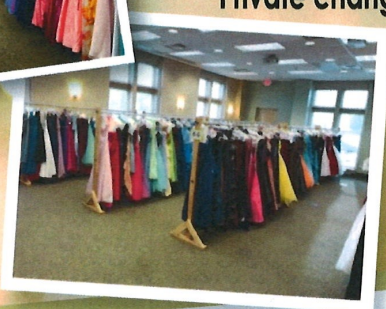
