### Principal's Message

Over the past month, I have been able to share some of the work that we have been doing with our students related to our Social-Emotional Learning goal. I'd like to share two more strategies that students have been focusing on to help students manage their emotions.

- Belly breaths - this is something that we have used schoolwide. To use this strategy, students can put a hand on their belly, then breath slowly so that they can see their hand move. They can continue to take slow, deep breaths until they feel more in control of their emotions.
- 5ER: students talk quite often in morning meetings about doing something kind for someone, as it will make both people feel good about themselves
