This assembly will include patriotic songs, videos, poems, and of course multiple opportunities for our students to learn about and show respect towards our Veterans. We would also like to welcome and honor any Veteran that your family knows to attend the assembly and be honored by our Anderson Students and Staff.



We need your help to prepare for this special day and ensure that all Veterans are welcomed and honored. The items listed below also give you a chance to have a conversation with your child and be involved in helping them learn about and honor our veterans.


