Warning Signs a Child Is Being a Bully Online

Is My Child/Student a Cyberbully?

- ◆ Minimizes the computer screen when an adult enters the room.
- ◆ Gets angry when he/she cannot use the computer.
- ◆ Laughs a lot while using the computer.
- ◆ Refuses to talk about what he/she does while on the computer or cell phone.
- ◆ Has multiple accounts.
- ◆ Has been a victim of cyberbullying.
- ◆ Has altered someone else's photo.
- ◆ Wants to use the computer in private.
- ◆ Refuses to allow an adult to view his/her messages.
- ◆ Goes to websites that rate appearance.
