Freshmen will take the [PSAT 9 exam](#), and Sophomores and Juniors will take the [PSAT/NMSQT](#) exam on Wednesday, October 10, 2018 during the school day. The PSAT/NMSQT exam is a preliminary SAT that also opens the door to consideration for National Merit scholarships. Seniors will not be in attendance and are encouraged to make college visits or complete college applications and essays that day. Seniors - we will offer application and essay assistance on a drop-in basis in our Main Commons. All students will be testing from 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Students will be dismissed at 12:30 p.m. after testing concludes. Room assignments will be published on posters around the building. Students taking the PSAT 9 or NMSQT with accommodations will receive an email with their specific test location and approved accommodations. Please use your PSAT study guide, Khan Academy or the SAT Daily Practice App to prepare for test day.


